Drug Testing:	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (under 18s) to be drug tested if approached.
Photography:	In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event must register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival.
Refreshments:	Food and drink, this will be dependent upon current guidelines. IF possible food and drink will be available from the club for the on competition days
Special Note:	Please advise the Tournament Organiser if you require assistance in collecting arrows.
Smoking:	At all times, smoking is prohibited on the Field of Play. The "Field of Play" is defined as the shooting area, including all required overshoot, and all areas behind the shooting line extending to a point at least five metres beyond the last archer's tent or shelter.
Car Parking:	Parking will be available on site for disabled archers and adjacent to the archery field for general parking

Travelling	 The competition is at Bowmen of Glen Archery Society, Newton Lane, Great Glen, Leicestershire. LE8 9AB This event is currently restricted to the number of competitors + Judges & Field Crew we can have on the field, so please travel alone if you can Drivers, parents and guardians have to be outside of the marked area, please do not gather, and please social distance Athletes who require assistance are asked to inform the TO in advance who will be assisting them on the day
Arrival	 Please DO NOT arrive before 7:00am Tents can be put up after 7:00am A member of the work crew will meet you for registration as you arrive in your car Under 18's will be asked for an emergency contact at this point
Parking	 A parking marshal will direct you Please leave plenty of room between cars to allow for social distancing
Tent Areas	 We are shooting 4 Archers per target on Saturday and 4 on Sunday. Please pitch your tents aligned with the lane edge and facing into the lane, as per the <u>Return to Competition</u> <u>Guidelines</u>
Equipment Inspection	 Judges will not touch any of your equipment Inspection will be visual; arrows must be marked as per the rules If bow scales are used for compounds they will be sanitised by the judges between each use and placed on a table for you to use.

PPE & Sanitiser	 Please provide whatever PPE you feel comfortable with Bring your own hand sanitiser Hand sanitiser stations will be made available to everyone on the field and should be used when you enter and leave the field.
Food and Drink	 The pavilion Café will be open. No bins will be provided on the field, please take all your rubbish away with you
Toilets	 Toilets in the clubhouse will be avaiable. There will be sanitiser stations near to the toilets Please wipe down all touch points with the wipes provided before and after use
First Aid	To minimise contact and possible cross contamination we would advise participants to bring their own small first aid kit for minor incidents. All incidents must be reported to the organisers.
Shooting Procedure	 Please ensure social distancing at all times Please keep shooting equipment in the waiting area boxes in front of the tents when not in use Scopes may be left on the line if you are second detail or everyone is shooting single detail.
Scoring etc	On each target one Archer will complete the paper scorecards and one the electronic tablet. These roles should not be swapped through the day. Please maintain social distancing at the target & with archers on the adjacent target. When score sheets need to be handed in, they should be signed, use your own pen please, and placed in a box near the DoS tent. We will be marking arrow holes. Archers should only mark and pull their own arrows.
