CLUBHOUSE

It looks as though we might finally be close to seeing some action with regards to the new clubhouse.

As outlined in the last newsletter, the plan is to replace the current structure on a new site in the vicinity of the three storage containers. The steel structure would offer a similar area to the existing clubhouse.

Current funds are sufficient to complete the build and also include a new waste management system thus allowing us to include new we's in the build and thus enable the demolition of the current toilet block.

If all goes well the work could commence this September with completion well before next Spring. This proposal is stage 1 of a 2 stage build. The second stage would offer an indoor shooting range. Stage 2 would be dependant on further funding.

The 'Clubhouse project' is on the Agenda to discuss at the up coming AGM.
