Event Format	<p>Junior tournaments will be run as a mixed gents and ladies tournament. The qualification round will be shot in double detail 6 arrows in 4 minutes and consist of 72 arrows, shot at 50m for compound on individual 6 zone 80cm faces, shot at 50m for barebow on 122cm faces and at 70m,60m for recurve on 122cm faces</p> <p>Elimination and finals rounds.</p> <p>Compound Head-to-Head will consist of 15 arrow matches shot in five ends of three arrows. All these matches will be shot at 50m on individual 6 zone 80cm faces.</p> <p>Barebow and Recurve will use the set system, elimination and finals will consist of a maximum of 5 sets of three arrows.</p> <p>Barebow Head-to-Head will be shot on 122 cm faces at 50m.</p> <p>Recurve Head-to-Head will be shot on 122 cm faces at 70m</p> <p>Due to field restrictions, there will no H2H session for 50+ at 60m.</p>

Archers should be fully familiar with WA Timing, Signals and Bouncer procedures.

- Awards:** Recurve, Compound, Longbow & Barebow
Ladies, Gents & Juniors
Awards according to entry
- Scoring:** Scoring will be carried as per WA rule 14. Please note, archers are responsible for making sure that all aspects of their scoresheet, arrow values, score values, golds, number of hits etc. are correct before signing (WA rule 14.4).
- Other Details:** Foam Bosses available.
NO GAZEBO'S, COOKING ONLY ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF ROPED AREA AND NOT WITHIN 2 METRES OF NEAREST TENT.
- Parking:** Please adhere to Parking Attendants for parking your car as cars cannot be parked on the road. Directions can be obtained from www.bowmenofglen.org
- Smoking:** At all times, smoking is prohibited on the Field of Play. The "Field of Play" is defined as the shooting area, including all required overshoot, and all areas behind the shooting line extending to a point at least five metres beyond the last archer's tent or shelter's
