Archers should be fully familiar with Timing, system Signals and Bouncer procedures.

- Awards:** Recurve, Compound, Longbow & Barebow
Ladies, Gents & Juniors
Awards according to entry
- Scoring:** It will be 10 Zone scoring and results will be displayed through lanseo system on the day
- Other Details:** Foam Bosses available.
NO GAZEBO'S, COOKING ONLY ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF ROPED AREA AND NOT WITHIN 2 METRES OF NEAREST TENT.
- Parking:** Please adhere to Parking Attendants for parking your car as cars cannot be parked on the road. Directions can be obtained from www.bowmenofglen.org
- Smoking:** At all times, smoking is prohibited on the Field of Play. The "Field of Play" is defined as the shooting area, including all required overshoot, and all areas behind the shooting line extending to a point at least five metres beyond the last archer's tent or shelter's
This also applies to E-cigarette's/vaping.
